



Volunteers needed for Wirksworth Toy Library!

Do you have a few hours a month to spare?

If you have, then you could be one of our fantastic volunteers who help keep Wirksworth Toy Library going by helping to run and supervise sessions.

Volunteers are needed to:

- Help run Toy Library sessions
- Put toys away
- Get toys out of the cupboards
- Book toys in and out on the computer system
- Supervise the Stay and Play craft activities



Sessions run on the 1st and 3rd Tuesday of every month from 1.30 - 3.00 p.m. You could help for one or two sessions a year, or on a more regular basis if you would like to. Toy Library is organised using a volunteer rota, so you can arrange to help whenever best suits you.

If you would like to become more involved and have a say in what we do - you could become one of our committee members. The committee meets 4 times a year and meetings are very informal - so children can come too.

Wirksworth Toy Library was set up by volunteers and is still run entirely by volunteers today. We welcome anyone able to help whether you have children of your own or not.

Our volunteers gain valuable experience and skills in childcare and customer service and have fun spending time with the children and socialising during their time at Wirksworth Toy Library.
